

Research infrastructures (RIs) are facilities that provide resources and services for the research communities to conduct research and foster innovation in their fields. This definition includes the associated human resources, and it covers major equipment or sets of instruments; knowledge-related facilities such as collections, archives or scientific data infrastructures; computing systems, communication networks, and any other infrastructure, of a unique nature and open to external users, essential to achieve excellence in research and innovation. Where relevant, they may be used beyond research, for example for education or public services.








BRNO - HOST CITY OF ICRI 2022

CHALLENGES TO THE RIS TO BE COVERED AT ICRI 2022



1) SOCIETAL BENEFITS AND SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY OF RIS

Global/regional dimension, trends and threats in society development, new policy imperatives for RIs to help with digital and green transition, role of universities and tertiary education, engagement of citizens.

2) INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AND THE ROLE OF RIS

Global to regional cooperation models, new ERA in the global perspective, transnational access to RIs.

3) DEVELOPING AN INTEGRATED RI ECOSYSTEM

Role of small and medium scale RIs next to large-scale international laboratories, global data management, toolboxes for RIs, mobility, careers of scientific and RI staff.



ICRI 2022 & MENDEL 200


